

A huge congratulations to every member of the Ferndale #1588 Lodge for our accomplishments in 2022/23. A total of 12 Lodge officers/members have returned from the State Convention held May 19-21, 2023, up at Ste. Saint Marie, Michigan with two outstanding awards. The Ferndale #1588 Lodge won our 8th consecutive Gold Star Award this year for the State of Michigan. Our Lodge also has won our 8th consecutive All American Lodge Award and additionally we are in the running for a National Award for All American. We find out about the National All-American award during the National Convention in Minneapolis, Minnesota being held July 2 – July 5, 2023. Upcoming meetings during the month of June include two Lodge meetings on Tuesday June 6th at 7:30pm and June 20th at 7:30pm (our next initiation). All Lodge meetings are open to everyone who is a member in good standing. Please remember to have your card with you and that you have signed the bottom of it when you come to a Lodge a meeting. You must present your membership card if you plan to attend a Lodge meeting.

Membership is the life blood of our organization, and it is key that we continue to reach out to friends, family members, neighbors, co-workers, and even first-time visitors to our lodge to encourage them to join. If you have a friend, family member, or co-worker that has been coming with you to the Lodge for several months and they have not joined yet, it is time to have a conversation about why they are not a member. They obviously enjoy coming to the Lodge and participating in our events, so let's take the next step and make them join. During the months of April and May 2023, we have initiated 22 new members with 24 in waiting, bringing our total membership to 781 members to date. Keep turning those applications in for membership as our Membership Chairman Steve Laurain has set a goal of 200 initiates this year. If you as a member get three new members to join (within 12 months July-June) you can earn your Grand Exalted Ruler Membership Pin. Keep those applications for membership coming in as we will be swearing in new members 2 times a month!

We received a ENF Grant to take Ferndale MOIC Special Needs kids to the Detroit Tigers baseball game Sept 28th, 2023. Events like this are made possible because of the generous donations of our members to the Elks National Foundation (ENF) program and making your \$10.00 contribution each year when you renew your dues. Each year that our Lodge meets our Per-Capita requirements we qualify for Grants such as the one used to take the kids to the Detroit Tiger Game. I encourage everyone to please donate \$10.00 to the ENF program, and this can be done when you renew your membership dues, or you can make a donation any time of the year by mailing a check to the Lodge and marking it "Attention Lodge Secretary". You can also make a donation in person by putting cash in an envelope with your information and giving it to a bartender for the Lodge Secretary. Donations of \$10.00 or more can be made once, or several times throughout the year to the ENF program. Many of the Ferndale #1588 Lodge Officers make a monthly \$10.00 donation to the ENF Fidelity program as part of their commitment to the Lodge and the ENF programs. We are doing great work in Ferndale and let's see if we can get our percentage of members donating above 75% this year..

I am reaching out to the roughly 100 Delinquent members who have not yet paid their 2023/24 membership dues to get those turned in to the Lodge Secretary ASAP. I am making a direct appeal to all the members who have not paid their 2023/24 membership dues yet to please send in your payment this week. We have mailed out dues' forms in February and again in May in an attempt to collect your membership dues. We have also sent out emails and text messages to those we have those records for on file. If you are having an issue making your payment please reach out to the Lodge Secretary to discuss at 248-542-2626. Let's get those dues sent in today please. Your membership dues allow the Ferndale #1588 Lodge to continue its works within our Community by giving back each year to the MOIC special needs kids, Ferndale Youth Assistance Program, Hamilton House Nursing Home for Disabled Veterans, sponsoring local events such as the Memorial Day Parade and the Easter Egg Hunt for the City of Ferndale, food baskets at Christmas time to help struggling families, granting scholarships to deserving High School students and much more. I am encouraging every member of the Ferndale #1588 Lodge to bring your dues current this week so we can move forward with many exciting things that are planned for the upcoming fraternal year and have you as part of those events.
