

Hunsanger, Carl

Mr. Carl Joseph Hunsanger, 77, of Ruth, died Sunday, February 29, 2004, at Huron County Medical Care Facility in Bad Axe under hospice care after a short illness. He was born October 10, 1926 in Ruth, son of the late August and Meta (Noechel) Hunsanger. He never married. Mr. Hunsanger was an 8th grade graduate of SS. Peter and Paul Catholic School in Ruth. Carl farmed in Ruth, retiring in 1990. He was a lifelong resident of Ruth and a parishioner of SS. Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Ruth. He was a volunteer firefighter for 24 years and a member of the Ruth Knights of Columbus Council #3823. He loved caring for his pets and animals. He also enjoyed bird watching and walking "Buddy", his dog. He was preceded in death by two sisters, Margaret Cook and Bernadette Doe; four brothers, Barney, Leo, Herb and Lawrence "Larry" Hunsanger.
