- 3. When they were born
- 4. What was going on around the world when they were born? **EXPLAIN in DETAIL**
- 5. What did they invent/ what are the famous for? **EXPLAIN in DETAIL**
- 6. Family information about both of the scientists
- 7. Did they work with another scientist? If so on what and with who?
- 8. Is there any museums, buildings, streets, parks, or anything named after the scientist? If so where is it?
