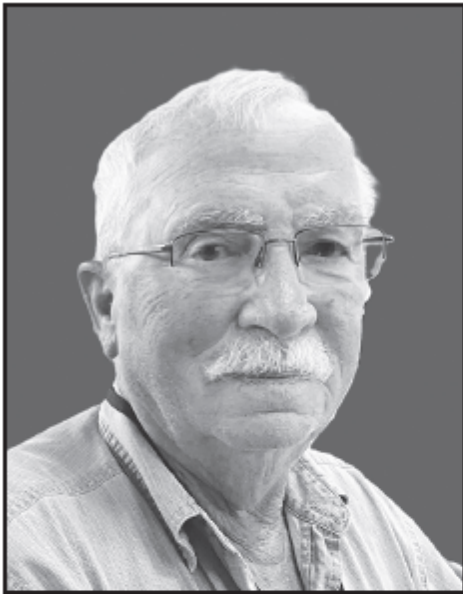


Robert "Bob" Nolan

It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Robert "Bob" Nolan. He was a dear husband to his wife Linda and wonderful father of four rambunctious boys (Chris of Tennessee, Sean, deceased, Illinois, Scott of Wyoming and Jim of Oregon) and grandad of 12, greatgrandad of 11 and great, greatgrandad of one.

Robert passed away at the age of 75 on April 7, 2025 after a long and well fought battle against cancer. Born on July 23, 1949 at Natrona County Memorial Hospital, he filled everyone's lives with love from the moment he came into the world.

Always a defender of the Faith and Country, Bob selflessly put his life on the line by volunteering for the US Marine Corps in 1967 and serving in Vietnam into 1969 and continued

to grow stronger in his Catholic faith to the end of his life. Curious and intelligent from a young age, Bob was always asking questions and open to new possibilities. He never lost this sense of wonder. He was always looking for that next rock that he was bringing home to his wife and together, they loved spending time in Wonderful Wyoming whether it was simple day trips, remote camping or spending time with their family that is strewn all over Wyoming and beyond. Bob is a 4th generation Wyoming Native and the spirit and fierce independence of Wyoming always ran deep in his heart.
