## **MINUTES**

The July 10, 2018 regular meeting of the Innsbrook Board of Trustees was held at Innsbrook Village Hall and called to order at 5:00 PM with Chairman Thomsen presiding. Chairman Thomsen led the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon Roll Call, Trustees Trish Dunn, Jerry Rust, Ted Sator, Tom Stevener and Jeff Thomsen were present. After roll call, Chairman Thomsen announced that a quorum was present for the transaction of business.

Also in attendance were Village Administrator/Clerk, Carla Ayala; Village Attorney, Jay Godsy; Carol Zuckner (Walkers Way); Keith Thompson and Chip Wobbe, Innsbrook Corporation.

## APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Motioned by Trustee Stevener, seconded by Trustee Rust, to approve the agenda. All Trustees present voted "Aye". Motion passed and approved with a 5-0 vote.

## APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Trustee Stevener suggested a correction on the regular meeting minutes. Under "Board of Trustee Comments", strike "Stracks Church Road." and enter "where state maintenance ends." in its place. Motioned by Trustee Sator, seconded by Trustee Stevener to approve the June 12, 2018, regular meeting minutes as corrected and executive session minutes. All Trustees present voted "Aye". Motion passed and approved with a 5-0 vote.

#### PUBLIC COMMENTS

Carol Zuckner asked for an update on the complaint property located at 15568 Walkers Way. Chairman Thomsen visited the property on July 8, 2018, confirming that no effort has been done to fix the nuisance complaints. The Village Attorney will now be able to send the occupants a violation notice and statement of probable cause.

Keith Thompson reviewed the site map for Tyrol Lake, which includes Plat 98, with the Trustees.

Motion passed and approved with a 5-0 vote.
- b. Administrator's Report Carla Ayala presented her report to the Trustees. Meet the Candidates Night will be held on Monday, July 16, 2018, 7:00pm at the Aspen Center. 12 building permits have been issued for the second quarter of 2018, totaling 25 permits for the 2018 year.
- c. Planning and Zoning Commission A meeting was held on June 27, 2018. After review and discussion, the Commission recommends approval of Plat 98 to the Board of Trustees.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

- a. BILL NO. 257 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING INNSBROOK ESTATES PLAT 98 FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF EIGHT (8) SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL SITES. (ORD. 254) Motioned by Trustee Rust, seconded by Trustee Stevener to have the first and second reading of Bill No. 257 by title only. All Trustees present voted "Aye". Motion passed and approved with a 5-0 vote. Chairman Thomsen read Bill No. 257 twice by title only. With no discussion, motioned by Trustee Sator, seconded by Trustee Stevener to enact Bill No. 257 as Ordinance No. 254. By roll call vote, Trustee Dunn "Aye", Trustee Rust "Aye", Trustee Sator "Aye", Trustee Stevener "Aye", Trustee Thomsen "Aye". With a 5-0 vote, Bill No. 257 is enacted as Ordinance No. 254 of the Village of Innsbrook, Missouri.
- b. Workers Compensation Renewal Motioned by Trustee Rust, seconded by Trustee Stevener, to approve the renewal of the Village Workers Compensation for 8/1/18 to 8/1/19 in the amount of \$932.00. All Trustees present voted "Aye". Motion passed and approved with a 5-0 vote.
