Summary: On July 19, 2021, P/O Lavender conducted a motor vehicle stop in the area of the 200 east block of Stockton Rd. During the motor vehicle stop, the driver, Mickey Morrell, was found to be under the influence.

With the assistance of the Wildwood Police Department K-9 Unit, the investigating officers also discovered that Mr. Morrell was in possession of a quantity of methamphetamine, drug paraphernalia, and clonazepam pills which were not prescribed to him.

Mr. Morrell was placed under arrest for driving while under the influence, possession of CDS and paraphernalia. Mr. Morrell was also charged with multiple traffic summons. The passenger in the vehicle, Zachary Bommentre, was also placed under arrest for possession of CDS and paraphernalia.

Mr. Morrell and Mr. Bommentre were later released with a future court date in accordance with New Jersey Bail Reform guidelines.
