A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY BY THE CITY
OF GARNETT OF AN AGREEMENT WITH VYVE BROADBAND A, LLC GOVERNING
THE DELIVERY OF VIDEO SERVICES UNDER VYVE'S KANSAS VIDEO
FRANCHISE AUTHORIZATION.

WHEREAS, Vyve Broadband A, LLC was granted authorization by the City of Garnett, Kansas, to provide video service within the City pursuant to Ordinance No. 3194, effective as of November 9, 1996; and,

WHEREAS, the franchise granted under said ordinance has expired and Vyve has filed an amendment to its Video Franchise Authorization issued by the Kansas Corporation Commission to include the City of Garnett, Kansas, effective November 8, 2016; and,

WHEREAS, the inclusion of the City of Garnett in said state franchise requires the parties to enter into an agreement, substantially in the form as attached hereto and marked "Exhibit A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GARNETT, KANSAS, that the mayor and city clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver an agreement with Vyve Broadband A, LLC substantially in the form of the agreement attached to this resolution and marked, "Exhibit A".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the city manager is hereby authorized and directed, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-2024(b), to request Vyve Broadband A, LLC, as the video service provider, to calculate a Video Service Provider Fee of 5% of its gross revenues from customers served in the Garnett system (CUID KS0700) and pay the same to the City of Garnett, Kansas, on a quarterly basis, as provided by law.

#### AGREEMENT

This Agreement (this "Agreement") is dated this \_\_\_\_\_ day of November, 2016 by and between Vyve Broadband A, LLC (the "Company") and the City of Garnett, Kansas (the "City").

WHEREAS, the Company was granted authorization by the City to provide video service within the City pursuant to that certain Ordinance No. 3194, effective as of November 9, 1996 (the "City Franchise"); and

WHEREAS, the City Franchise will expire pursuant to its terms on November 8, 2016; and

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2016 the Company filed an amendment to its Video Franchise Authorization issued by the Kansas Corporation Commission (the "KCC") of the State of Kansas on May 29, 2013 (the "State Franchise") to include the City in its existing service area footprint commencing November 8, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 12, Article 2024(a) of the Kansas Statutes Annotated requires that a video service provider providing service in a municipality under a state-issued franchise enter into an agreement with such municipality containing the terms and conditions set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto hereby agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Notice and Acknowledgement of State-Issued Franchise</u>. The City hereby acknowledges and agrees that the Company's provision of video services in the City will be governed by the terms and conditions of the State Franchise, effective as of November 8, 2016.
- 2. <u>Contact Information</u>. The Company may be contacted by the City at the following telephone number: (914) 234-8300. The Company may be contacted by customers at the following telephone number: 1-855-FOR-VYVE. The Company agrees to update this contact information with the City within 15 calendar days in the event that such contact information changes.
- 3. <u>Rights-of-Way</u>. The Company acknowledges and agrees to comply with the City's local right-of-way ordinance to the extent the ordinance is applicable to the Company and not contrary to state and federal laws and regulations. The Company hereby reserves the right to challenge the lawfulness or applicability of such ordinance to the Company.
- 4. <u>Reservation of Rights</u>. By entering into this agreement, neither the municipality's nor the Company's present or future legal rights, positions, claims, assertions or

arguments before any administrative agency or court of law are in any way prejudiced or waived. By entering into this Agreement, neither the City nor the Company waive any rights, but instead expressly reserve any and all rights, remedies and arguments the City or the Company may have at law or equity, without limitation, to argue, assert and/or take any position as to the legality or appropriateness of any present or future laws, ordinances and/or rulings.

- 5. <u>Filing with Clerk</u>. The City hereby agrees to file this fully executed Agreement with the City Clerk and deliver a copy of the same to the Company.
- 6. Governing Law. This Agreement shall be governed by, interpreted and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Kansas, without giving effect to any choice or conflict of law provision or rule thereof.
- 7. <u>Counterparts</u>. This Agreement may be executed in two counterparts, each of which as so executed shall be deemed to be an original but both of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument. A signature delivered by facsimile, email or other means of electronic delivery shall be acceptable as an original for all purposes.


