

The Brownstown Fire Department conducts juvenile fire setter's intervention programs for parents who may have a child who has been setting fires within or around the home. This program is designed to better determine the underlying issue(s) which are causing these children to set fires. The program is conducted at the Brownstown Fire Department Administrative Offices by appointment by trained personnel in the field of juvenile fire setting.

The program usually takes about 1 to 1 ½ hours to complete. The child is interviewed using a scientifically designed program along with parent questioners and other information gathering techniques. At the conclusion of the program a profile is determined from the information. Information is then given to the parents ranging from techniques they can work on with the child such as curiosity fire setting to more extreme conditions that will require professional referral intervention.
