A. Virgil C. Webb

Virgil C. Webb was a life-long resident of Bondurant, Iowa. He farmed his family farm and eventually was the rural postal carrier later in his life. He enjoyed music by singing in church and for others. He was known for his generosity by giving away his sweet corn and his garden products, all renowned for their taste, quality and size. Virgil realized he would not outlive his investments and requested his family holdings be invested in the Bondurant community. His first concern was for graduates from Bondurant-Farrar High School who wanted to go to college for music and had financial limitations. He was also concerned for financially needy and deserving graduates of Bondurant-Farrar High School, who wish to attend a four-year college or university majoring in something other than music. This scholarship is not available for internet based colleges/universities.

B. General Information

The Virgil C. Webb, William Garber and Flora Webb Garber Foundation (“Foundation”) was initiated to provide scholarships to financially needy and deserving senior graduates from Bondurant-Farrar High School. First consideration for the scholarships is financial need. This scholarship will cease in 2028.

Only complete applications will be considered

- Scholarship is available to only to an accredited four year college or university in the United States. Internet based institutions are not eligible.
- The scholarship may cover tuition and fees for up to 30 credit hours per academic year.
- The scholarship is available for undergraduate studies during the first four years after graduation from high school.
- Applicant must reside in the 2009 Bondurant-Farrar Community School District when graduated.
- College student application consists of:
 - Financial information including:
 - FAFSA Student Aid Index (SAI) and FAFSA Submission Summary, including scholarships and amounts
 - Student and parent financial statements (forms included in application)
 - Signed student's and parents' tax returns for prior year (2025)
 - Official transcript of your high school grades sent by Bondurant-Farrar High School and official transcript from college/university (see Consent to Release of Grades and Academic Information)
 - Letter of recommendation from college professor or counselor (form included).
 - Personal letter of recommendation (**someone not associated with the university**), form included
 - An original essay on “What significant post secondary academic event has solidified your decision for graduation in your major?”
 - Complete list of any certificates, honors or awards you have received
 - Scholastic, collegiate and community involvement and service
 - Consent to Release of Grades and Academic Information

The scholarship award winner must

- provide a fall semester schedule of classes and student account statement showing amounts for tuition books and fees (Ubill)
- maintain a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 in all coursework
- complete a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester (credit hours are class hours)

- o figured into the GPA). Class hours are not necessarily credit hours; e.g., pass/fail/audit.
- o continue to be a student in good standing by abiding by the policies of the Bondurant-Farrar High School Student Handbook and/or the college or university
- o fulfill the academic responsibilities of the award
- o provide semester grade results and the spring college class schedule to the Managing Directors of the Foundation after the fall semester along with college UBill
- o applicant must be a citizen of the United States

College Student scholarship applicants are asked to submit a completed application by June 30th of each year. The application will be reviewed by the Managing Directors and approved by the Board of Directors of the Foundation. The application will be scored. Scholarship awards **will be limited** in 2026-2027 to funds allocated and quality and quantity of applications. Additional information may be requested and a personal interview may be required. The scholarship award winners will be notified by mail.

C. Award Amounts

Award amounts may vary with each student. Students who qualify and are selected will be awarded scholarship funds. The Managing Directors supervise these student award accounts. If a student drops below full time designation, or drops from the college or university during the refund period, the Foundation may request a refund of the scholarship from the college/university. A student in good standing who has fulfilled previous award obligations may apply each year for the award. Preference will be given first to high school graduates and then to college students requesting a renewal of the award or a new application for existing college student. Award determinations will not be discussed.

D. Scholarship Payment -

Awarded scholarships will be paid by semester. A student qualifies each semester. The first award payment will be one-half of total award (1/3 for trimesters) on or before August 10. **Students must submit the fall semester schedule and UBill prior to submission of funds to the college/university. The second semester award payment (and third for trimesters) will be made after the Foundation receives the student's fall transcript, UBill and class schedule for the spring semester.** The following factors may be grounds for discontinuing the award: the student's **failure to maintain minimum grade point average; the student's failure to carry and complete 12 credit hours per semester (college credit hour is are completed class hours computed in grade point average, not class hours)**, the inability of the student to work harmoniously with faculty and/or fellow students; and the student's failure to make significant progress toward a degree; or a serious violation of the law or of Bondurant-Farrar High School or college/ university policies and regulations. The scholarship payment will be to the lesser of the amount due on the student account statement or scholarship. The Board of Directors of the Foundation reserves the right to refuse a semester payment or renewal. Students may re-apply for this award so long as they have complied with the conditions of the award and there are funds allocated by the Foundation. Renewal is not automatic for this scholarship.

The Virgil C. Answer **ALL** questions. **If a question does not apply to you, enter "ZERO or N/A."** Questions left blank will cause lengthy delays in the processing of your application. You must also submit all income tax and earnings statements related to the information on this application, and all financial information, as well as a FAFSA application printout. **Parent information is REQUIRED** of all dependent applicants to undergraduate programs. Make sure all required parties sign this application before you return it.

Privacy Notice Concerning Financial Information

For the Virgil C. Webb, William Garber and Flora Webb Garber Foundation, the protection of the privacy of the personal information submitted by applicants and their parents/guardians is of paramount importance and we take this responsibility very seriously. Scholarship determination will not be discussed.

Financial details will be available only to the Managing Directors. The completed application (excluding the financial information) will be available to the Board of Directors.

Security Practices: We will emphasize the importance of confidentiality through director training, the implementation of procedures designed to protect the security of our records, and our privacy policy. We will restrict access to the personal financial information of our applicants and their parents/guardians to those directors who need to know that information to perform their grant authorization responsibilities. We will maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards to guard your non-public, personal financial information. We do not have encrypted email service and request that no personal data or financial information be submitted over an Internet email service. Note that no transmission of data over the Internet is guaranteed to be completely secure. It may be possible for hackers or other third parties not under the control of the Foundation to intercept or access transmissions or private communications unlawfully. While we strive to protect your personal information, we cannot ensure or warrant the security of any information you transmit to us by means of the internet.
