



Multi-Chlor

Required PPE

Chemical-resistant safety glasses, goggles, or face shield to prevent eye contact.

Face & Eyes

Multi-Chlor can cause severe eye damage.



Side Shields



Goggles



A face shield provides full-face protection. Always wear eye protection under a face shield.

Chemical-resistant gloves and clothing to avoid skin contact.

Skin

Multi-Chlor can cause severe skin burn.



Wear chemical resistant clothing such as a rubber apron. Butyl rubber, Neoprene, or nitrile gloves must be worn when handling Multi-Chlor.

Respiratory apparatus that prevents chlorine particles from entering your airway.

Respiratory

Extreme Danger for respiratory tract irritation.

Do not breathe in mist or vapor.



Must wear respiratory protective equipment when handling open container of Multi-Chlor.

Additional Personal Safety Measures

Use only outdoors or in a well-ventilated area.
Wash thoroughly after handling.
Know the location of eye wash facility and emergency shower at every service location where you use Multi-Chlor.

Don't wait for an incident to become acquainted with your Multi-Chlor Safety Data Sheet (SDS).
