As part of the grant deliverables, we need to demonstrate use of the data. Michael will do a presentation as part of the September NCRTAC meeting on our data and then the RTAC will need to identify some priorities for follow up. Lexi Bandt's position with DHS is no longer funded and she is no longer part of the office. Before leaving she shared a mortality data report which has been forwarded to the NCRTAC PI committee. Still working on releasing the Falls and annual data reports. As EMS is being better funded for projects through FAP, DHS has asked us to refrain from awarding RTAC project grants to services/projects that could be funded by FAP. 75 services in NCRTAC got \$2.6M in FAP grants this year ranging from \$10,000 - \$155,000 The Falls Free Wisconsin Coalition is looking for participation in committees.
