Regular Meeting -----September 15, 1987

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, D. L. Taylor at 7:00 A.M. Other Grand County Water Conservancy District members present were Gary Wilson, John Groo. ATTENDANCE

Roberta read the minutes of the meeting of September 1, 1987. After calling for corrections or additions, the chair declared the minutes approved as read. D. L. asked about the letter from the Moab Irrigation, and Dale gave the background on the flows to Moab Irrigation Co. It was suggested another grate be put on the diversion to keep the flows open. Dale reported the money that the MCDA asked for to buy the pipe for the golf course irrigation system estimate is approximately \$40,000.00. the estimate for the pipe is \$18,000.00. The pipe is in to the golf course (3,150 feet left to lay down Spanish Valley Drive, and one interconnect. They are working only on weekends, and three weekends should see the project finished. He will put together the length figure and will get the MCDA's pipe ordered today. GOLF COURSE INTERNAL IRRIGATION SYSTEM

Dale states that Paul Rattle had improved a road on George White's property, (easement given to Kerby, Rattle had bought from Kerby). When the project was put down the road, Mr. Rattle had told Dale there was 2' of cobble beneath the roadbed. When the trench was dug, the crew found no cobble. D.L. read the letter to him from Paul Rattle regarding his complaints. It was suggested the road be watched, and if the trench settles, to put in more gravel. RIGHT-OF-WAY MATTERS
