ADMISSIONS

House Bill 944 (King/Estes) –

Persons with nontraditional secondary education. Prohibits a public institution of higher education from having different admissions requirements for students who have completed a nontraditional secondary education. An institution may not require these students to obtain or submit a GED certificate or an equivalency to a public high school degree and may not require these students to take an examination or comply with any other application or admission requirement that is not applicable to other applicants.

This act takes effect on September 1, 2003 and applies to admissions on or after this date.
