IAIP EVALUATION AREAS

ACCSC expects institutional assessment and improvement goal setting, benchmarking, and implementation activities for sections 6 through 17 (as listed above). For each evaluation area:

- Describe evaluation criteria and assessment methods.
- Include an assessment report with the data collected.
- Include an analysis of the assessment and conclusions.
- Establish an action plan to address areas of improvement.
- Document all IAIP meetings with minutes and revised quarterly action plan.
