

In verse 23, Jesus says, Capernaum was exalted unto heaven. – What is Jesus talking about?

For over a year--During His entire Galilean ministry--Jesus lived in Capernaum! Heaven is the place of Jesus throne, and Jesus had chosen to live in Capernaum and they were exalted like Heaven is because Jesus had lived there. Think how that impacts you and me.

If you are trusting in Jesus today, you are exalted like heaven is because Jesus has made His home in your heart. Paul says we are seated together with Him in the heavenly realms! (Ephesians 2:6)

There is a lesson for us as we look at this rebuke of Capernaum. While they were not sensitive to Jesus in their presence, we should be sensitive to Jesus in our hearts!

We should always be sensitive to Jesus by serving Him faithfully.

#### Angels – Part 2

Angels are amazing creatures, and the reality is there is a variety of kinds. Some marvelously described, such as in Revelation. In 4:6-8, there are living ones who are around the throne of God, but John gives perceptive description to each, as a lion, a calf, a face like a man, and like a flying eagle. This general description is only topped by what follows in verse 8: each with six wings, full of eyes, never resting, and constantly proclaiming: "Holy, holy, holy!"

This rare glimpse into the throne room of heaven shows that Angels cannot help but praise God and worship Him. What is fascinating about this passage in Revelation is that Isaiah saw virtually the same thing, in chapter 6 of his book. Here we are given the name for this kind of Angel: Seraphim. (When most think of Angels, they probably think of beings with wings. Biblically, only the Seraphim and Cherubim (Exodus 25:20) are said to have wings.)

In Isaiah 6, we see the sight had a personal impact on Isaiah, not at seeing the Seraphic Angels, but at seeing the Lord Almighty: "Woe is me, for I am a man of unclean lips."

Seeing God is a humbling experience. Unlike Isaiah who was in God's throne room, I wonder how we reflect on being God's temple. Jesus Loves you!
