

NOTICE TO ALL CURRENT TR RESIDENTS....

Park Management contacted Pasco County Department of Health Emergency Management about coming to Travelers Rest some time ago. They responded yesterday evening and said they are out of vaccine, but if we could get them a list of individuals with their age on it they would put us in for doing a drive through inoculation as soon as they can. Pasco County's focus is on the higher risk individuals. They shared the following:

- At present Pasco County does not have any COVID vaccine but expects to receive some soon
- Once residents and staff in long-term care facilities and assisted living facilities have received vaccine, they hope to be able to bring the vaccine to residents of over-55 communities such as Travelers' Rest.
- In preparation for bringing vaccine to over-55 communities, they need to know how many would take the vaccine and the ages of the individuals.

The President, Board of Directors, has asked the First Responders to gather the information about who wants the vaccine, and assist the park management in planning the on-site logistical support of a Department of Health vaccine team if they are able to come.

Note that the second dose of the vaccine will be 21 or 28 days after the first, so you will need to be here for at least another month. Indicating your interest does NOT obligate you to receive the vaccine here at TR; it is acceptable to receive the vaccine at another location, if you have the opportunity and choose to do so.

Please tear off the bottom of this letter, fill it out if you and others at your address want the vaccine, and return it BY FRIDAY, January 15th to Chief Larry Polzin, Lot 04-29.
