Position Title: Wastewater Technician

Job Description: You will be required to travel throughout Ohio visiting Wastewater Treatment plants, where you will provide technical assistance, training, and advice to association members. You will be required to fulfill the contractual requirements of the National Rural Water Association program, which includes traveling to National Conferences and training events that span multiple days. You will be required to assist with annual State Conferences and Expositions. You will also be responsible for recruiting new members and maintaining relations with current members.

Experience/Education: The Wastewater Technician should possess, at a minimum, education equivalent to graduation from high school and multi-year experience in operating and/or managing a rural and/or small municipal wastewater system. The Wastewater Technician shall possess knowledge of operations and maintenance to include collection system experience and possess a well-rounded knowledge of rural and/or small wastewater system operations, management, and financial needs. The Wastewater Technician should possess, at a minimum, the equivalent of an Ohio Class I Wastewater Operators Certification License.

Essential Functions:

1. Provide technical assistance to rural and small municipal wastewater systems by visiting the system
2. Attend ORWA sponsored events as requested by the Executive Director and assist as necessary
3. Attend other meetings and functions relative to wastewater as a representative of ORWA
4. Provide timely information and reports on field operations which are necessary to publicize wastewater technical activities and services, included but not limited to, monthly reports on contractual activities and adherence to the association's goals and objectives
5. Prepare or provide technical information for association publications as requested by the Publication Editor
6. Assist in the planning and implementation of annual conventions, training seminars and other special programs
7. Assist the Executive Director as necessary in attaining the goals and objectives of the association
8. Take responsibility for all equipment issued to your care and ensure proper use and maintenance as prescribed by the manufacturer. Records of such maintenance shall be maintained for each piece of equipment
9. Perform other duties assigned by the Executive Director
