## ANDERSON COUNTY KANSAS TO HAVE KANSASWORKS MOBILE WORKFORCE CENTER

Anderson County, Kansas will be one of several counties that has been chosen to receive a monthly stop from the newest Mobile Workforce Center in Kansas. The Mobile Workforce Center will stop in Garnett on the third Wednesday of each month from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. and will be located at 109 South Oak Street, in front of the Anderson County Annex on the East side of Oak Street. The first visit to Anderson County will be on **Wednesday, February 19** from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.

The 38-foot Mobile Workforce Center includes 6 Internet-ready computer stations to assist job candidates and employers, an interactive SMART Board for presentations inside the Center and a high-definition TV, external speakers for presentations outside the Center as well as an internal public address system.

KANSASWORKS personnel accompany the Mobile Center and are available to provide the WorkKeys Testing, career counseling and resume building assistance. The Mobile Workforce Center can also be used throughout the state for job fairs, career development workshops, tutorials, skills training and other employment services. An appointment for career services is not required however if you plan to take the WorkKeys tests an appointment would be required.

Everyone is welcome and there is no charge for the services or testing provided by the Mobile Workforce Center.
