DESCRIPTION: The Necedah X-26 was redesigned in 1972 and generally made from Im-buya. This one is made of Maple, similar to the earlier Manitou line. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines. There is quite a bit of faint crazing (checkering of the varnish) - see pics. Up close, one can see the riser finish is not in the best shape either. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decals are visible and in fair condition. Overall, this is a structurally sound bow in good condition for its age. If someone had the time or money, this bow would be a good candidate for a complete strip-down and refinish.
