




SPRING HOSPITAL REPORT 2017

To: All Local Hospital Officers

I hope that your 2017 Auxiliary year is off to a good start and finds you all working hard on your hospital projects. Your projects should include any activity that benefits a VA Hospital, community hospital, or medically staffed nursing home.

I was pleased with the mid-year reports. We had 15 Auxiliaries report a total of 115 projects, 151 volunteers with 8,634 hours for a total evaluation of \$201,813. We also had 2 Auxiliaries report youth volunteers. There were 12 young volunteers with 134 hours for a total evaluation of \$3,458. With total like this, I can't wait to receive your end of the year reports.

Just a few reminders about the end of the year reports:

- Three copies of reports need to be sent to me (42 Campbell Avenue, Buffalo, NY 14216) postmarked no later than April 25th.
- Remember to include the totals from your mid-year report in your Annual Report. Also, please remember to round all totals to the nearest dollar.
- A mid-year report had to be sent in to be eligible to qualify for an award at convention, however, this does not mean you cannot send in an end-of-year report. All Hospital projects should be included in our Annual totals.

This year my Chairman's Award will go to the Auxiliary that hosts the most unique event/fundraiser to benefit St. Jude Children's Research Hospital.

An official copy of his/her high school transcript, must accompany the application. The copy of a letter of acceptance on official school letterhead from an accredited college or university must accompany the application.

An essay of approximately 250 words, stating the applicant's goals and objectives for the future must accompany the application.

All applications must be postmarked no later than May 1st. Please make certain that all the required materials are included with the application form. - Give a thorough financial report at each meeting to keep members updated and make the report available.



As Sergeant-at-Arms, I am responsible for the custody of the Department colors. Our flag, as you will notice, is in perfect condition, and is displayed in a place of honor, to the right of the speaker. However, when a flag is so worn that it is no longer fit to serve as a symbol of our country, it should be destroyed by burning it in a dignified manner. Most American Legion Posts conduct a dignified flag burning ceremony, most oftern on Flag Day, June 14. Please contact your local American Legion Halls to inquire about the availability of this service should you so need.

On your table is an article entitled, <u>Did You Ever Wonder Why Our Flag is Folded in a Triangle?</u>. I hope you enjoy it ans pass it on to your local auxiliary.

AMVETS Ladies Auxiliary recognizes the official uniform as an A-Line forest green dress, an A-line forest green skirt or tailored forest green slacks. The Dress shall have a jewel neckline. A White or gold blouse may be worn with either the skirt or slakes. The dress and skirt should be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee and no longer than 4 inches below the knee. Black shoes with a closed heal and toe are part of the uniform and the heal should be no higher than 2 inches. A Black handbag, white gloves, and official Ladies Auxiliary hat are also part of the uniform. Pearl earrings and single strand necklace or Auxiliary necklace and earrings will be acceptable. The jewlery is available from the Quartermaster. White shoes and purse may be worn from April until Labor Day.

Please remember that if you are interested and wish to receive a door prize, please bring a small wrapped gift to the June Convention. This should be a little something to exhcange, perhaps from the dollar store.

Dear Department President Candy, Department and Local Officers and Guests:

PARLIAMENTARY PROCEDURES are a set of rules for conduct at meetings, that allows everyone to be heard and to make decisions without confusion. Because it's a time- tested method of conducting business at your meetings, it is important that everyone know the basic rules. Please be reminded that the Auxiliaries that have ByLaw revisions for this year are as follows: #14, #48, #72, #219, #72 and 8113.

We should all know that the Order of Business is: Call to Order, Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance, Reading of Preamble and hopefully have the Code of Ethics read, Minutes,

Treasurer's Report, Correspondence, Officers Reports, Unfinished Business, New Business, Presentation of Bills, Prayer, Flag Salute and Motion to close.

The method used by members to express themselves is in the form of Motions. A Motion is a proposal that the entire membership act or a stand on an issue. Individual members can: Call to order, second the Motion, debate the Motion (on the question) and vote on the Motion. Motions are presented by:

- 1.) Obtaining the floor
 - a.) Wait until the last speaker has finished
 - b.) Rise and address Madam President
 - c.) Wait until Madam President recognizes you
- 2.) Make your Motion: Speak in a clear and concise manner. (Remember your Secretary is taking notes) Always state a motion affirmatively. Say "I move that we..." rather than "I move that we do not..." Avoid personalities and stay on your subject.
- 3.) Another member will second your Motion or Madam President will call for a second. If there is no second your Motion is lost.
- 4. Madam President will say "It has been moved and seconded that we..." By doing this, she is placing your Motion before the membership for consideration and action. The membership either debates your Motion, or may move directly to vote. Once your Motion is presented to the membership by Madam President, you cannot change it without consent of the members.

Parliamentary Procedure is the best way to get things done at your meetings. But, it will only work if you use it properly.

- 1.) Allow motions that are in order.
- 2.) Have members obtain the floor properly
- 3.) Speak clearly and concisely.
- 4.) Obey the rules of debate.


