DESCRIPTION: This Herter's Olympian is a nice shooting bow. Brazilian Rosewood riser. Black face limbs, and Herter's Trademark "Desert Tan" back limbs. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Some discoloration of the limbs. Decal is a reproduction. This bow was put to a long stress test, especially to test what was possibly some distress to the lower back limb fiberglass (see pic on last page). The bow was held at full draw for 36 hours to make sure the old glues still held, there was no delamination, and no cracks developed. It passed the test. Then bow was taken to the range and test shot. **Comes with a new string.**
