

Mall settles injury suit for \$1 million, lawyer says

A Van Nuys woman has received a \$1 million settlement in a lawsuit she filed against the Panorama Mall

shopping center for injuries she suffered when she fell over a metal drainage grate, her attorney said Thursday.

Dean Moray and Howard Kapp, of the Los Angeles law firm of Moray and Moray, said

the \$1 million received by Tammy Still is one of the largest settlements ever received for this type of case in Los Angeles.

"It wasn't enough for all the needless suffering I had to go

through," Still said. "Physically it will always be with me. I will never be able to go back to where I was before. It also did a lot of harm emotionally."

Kapp and Moray said the case was settled in February.
