I am watching the news and I have become worried about the extremist violence that may be coming our way, not just politically, but also religiously and spiritually. As the historian Ken Burns noted just a few days ago, we are not yet at the level of disturbance of the American Civil War, but we are at the level of disturbance of the Civil Rights Movement and the resistance to the Vietnam War. That is troubling enough.

But we are also very tired, exhausted even. People are distancing themselves from the news and rhetoric of the day. I know I am. The last few weeks many of you have taken me aside and expressed similar concerns. I have said this before, but there is a psycho-social dynamic called "psychic numbing," wherein we can just simply no longer take in the news of the day. It has become too traumatic to us. When the news comes on, we have to change the channel to something more benign.

As the UN Secretary General, Antonio Guterres, has said, the world has gone off its rails, spiritually, mentally, and socially. The relentless extremism and authoritarianism has become exhausting. So, perhaps we do what I have suggested before – be still, cease striving, stop and listen to each other, pray and meditate. Make small moves against destruction.

We cannot fix things all by ourselves. It takes a village. It takes small acts of kindness. Brave steps against hatred and fear-mongering in our own backyards. One person at a time. One step at a time.

Which is why Jesus healed, forgave, and had table-fellowship-with-sinners one person at a time. He didn't run for office. He didn't run for bishop. He met with tired, exhausted people and fed them, revitalized them.

And, even though it crucified him, it changed the world. So, even though small moves against destruction may crucify us, know clearly and confidently that such moves will change the world around us. The God who raised the Crucified One from the dead, will also raise us from our exhaustion and weariness. And, that is enough.

October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month

October is breast cancer awareness month, and experts say early detection is key to fighting breast cancer.

The American Society of Breast Surgeons recommends getting a mammogram every year starting at age 40 for a normal risk woman. High risk women, however, are recommended to start getting regular mammograms at age 30. Significant family history of cancer and

certain genetic mutations are factors that could allow a woman to be considered high risk.

About 1 in 8 women in the US develop invasive breast cancer. It is the most common cancer in women and the deadliest after lung cancer.
