

Allegations of Sexual Assault and/or Sexual Harassment

In accordance with the Prison Rape Elimination Act, standards 115.22 and 115.54, it is the policy of the Southside Regional Jail to investigate all allegations of sexual abuse and sexual harassment to include any third-party reported allegations.

All cases involving criminal behavior will be referred to the Greenville County Sheriff's Department.

Southside Regional Jail will be responsible for all administrative investigations into sexual abuse and sexual harassment allegations. If potential criminal behavior is revealed, the Superintendent or designee will refer the incident to the Greenville County Sheriff's Office.

If sufficient evidence substantiates a claim of sexual misconduct, the Emporia/Greenville County Commonwealth's Attorney's Office will be contacted.
