The Washington State Office of the Insurance Commissioner, in conjunction with PSI, is pleased to announce that all insurance examinations in Washington State will be available for remote testing on a compatible device with specific internet connectivity speeds beginning March 2, 2020.

The remote testing option allows an exam candidate to take their insurance exam practically anywhere (home, office, on vacation, etc.) on their laptop or desktop with an internet connection. Please note that your device, not a smartphone or tablet, will be tested for compatibility when you register.

The OIC remote testing option began in October 2019 as a pilot project on a limited basis for single line exams (life, disability, property, casualty, and personal lines) and was the first state insurance department to “go live” with this option for exam candidates.
