West Groton Water Supply District Report of the Water Commissioners

During the calendar year 2023, the following has been accomplished:

• The Federal Audit was completed by Powers & Sullivan. The District's finances were reported in good order.

• Upgraded our meter reading software and hardware.

• A wireless access point was added at the Townsend Road Pump Station, enabling a strong Wi-Fi signal inside the pump station.

Purchased a 2023 Chevrolet Silverado 2500 pick-up truck.

• Our Water Technician, Alex, completed his coursework and testing to obtain his D2 Water Operator License.

• Maintained excellent water quality, including PFAs levels remaining well below the guidelines.

• Received our Water Management Act Registration renewal which is now in effect until April 2033.

• Tank cleanings and inspections were done for the Kemp Street tank and the Academy Hill tank, and both are were found to be in great condition.

• Our Distribution Map was updated to include Bluebird Lane.

• Maintained an excellent rating of "AA with a stable outlook" from Standard & Poor.

• Took advantage of increasing interest rates to grow our reserve funds.

• Continued the replacement of old SENSUS meters with the new Badger meters (6 meters replaced in 2023).
