

2018- 19 PARK PROJECT

Sidney Township Park was started by two friends, Donald Petersen and Frank Drews, donating land to the township in early 1950's with a shared love for baseball. Residents joined together during their free time to construct the baseball field which has been used by independent adult leagues, the high school, pony leagues and local church leagues ever since.

In 1976, a pavilion was built when Sidney celebrated their centennial , a second pavilion with updated playground equipment and basketball court was added years later with donations from Sidney State Bank and memorial funds.

In 2016, the township purchased an additional acre to the north of park for extra parking during those busy summer weekends.

Now in 2018, we are asking residents to once again join together to improve our park. We do not want to ask for a millage to raise taxes to update our park so instead, we are asking for donations to update our playground.
