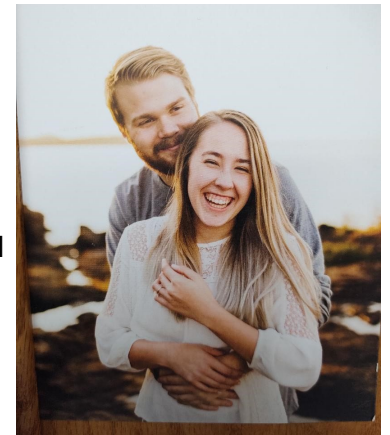


21 Days of Prayer: January 6th (Mon.) - 26th (Sun.)
