

ORDINANCE NO. 44

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING UNREASONABLE ACCELERATION AND UNREASONABLE BRAKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE CITY OF NEW MUNICH AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFORE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW MUNICH, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS

Section 1. Any unreasonable acceleration or unreasonable braking of any motor vehicle on any public street, alley, sidewalk, parking lot, or any other public right of way or public property within the City of New Munich is hereby declared to be a public nuisance and is prohibited.

Section 2. (a) Unreasonable acceleration is defined as acceleration which is not the result of an emergency and is in such a manner as to cause squealing or screeching sounds by the tires of said vehicle, or the throwing of sand or gravel by the tires of said vehicle, or both.

(b) Unreasonable braking is defined as braking, not in the course of making an emergency stop, in such manner as to cause squealing or screeching sounds by the tires of said vehicle, or the throwing of sand or gravel by the tires of said vehicle, or both

Section 3. PENALTY. Any person violating any provisions of this ordinance, namely causing a public nuisance as defined, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, subject to a fine of not to exceed \$300.00 and/or imprisonment not to exceed 90 days.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage and publication.
