Often when I am afraid or uncertain, I lean on a sermon the president gave while I was in seminary. One of our beloved classmates took his life and the campus of LTSS was devastated. We, as a community, had so many questions. We, as individuals, had so many questions. We cried together, wondered together, processed together, and yet there was still a deep pain that couldn't seem to be eased. We gathered in the chapel where Dr. Clayton Schmit began his sermon with this: In times of uncertainty, we focus on what we know: "I know that my redeemer lives!"

Sometimes on I recall the feelings from those sad days at seminary and then I remember that Dr. Schmit was called to remind us to focus on facts and what God has done, is doing, and promises yet to do. Here are the facts, the TRUTH: God loves us! God promises to be with us until the end!

God gave us promises of companionship even in the very commission of going to share the gospel. Matthew writes: *<sup>19</sup>Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup>and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.*"

God promises to be with us in storms, peace, ups, down, happy, sad, and times when we just don't begin to how we feel. Lean on God. Take all your worries and cares to him! He can handle – and He can give you peace and comfort.
