other grooming tool (comb, zoom groom, etc.) to the evaluation. Canine Good Citizen is a certification program developed by the AKC that is designed to reward the owners of dogs who are well mannered both at home and in the community. Test items include:

Supervised separation Appearance and grooming Coming when called

Accepting a friendly stranger Walking on a loose lead Reaction to another dog Sitting and laying down on command including staying in place on command

Sitting politely for petting Walking through a crowd Reaction to a distraction

Soft Liverwurst and Pumpkin Treats

Preheat oven to 350.

Ingredients:

16 oz. Liverwurst/Braunschweiger

16 oz. Pureed Pumpkin

2 cups whole wheat flour

eat flour

Mix the 3 ingredients in a food processor. Spread on a large cookie sheet lined with aluminum foil and sprayed with Pam or olive oil.

Bake at 350 degrees for 30-40 minutes, or until dry and "spongy." Let cool. Cut into training sized treats. Freeze them in snack size bags so they are ready for training.
