What is the Junior Theatre Festival?

JTF West is the Junior Theatre Festival West. Groups come from all over the country to compete in different categories. Teen, Youth, Middle School. We are competing in the Youth Division, which means all of our performers must be in 8th grade or younger at the time of competition. There are several opportunities to watch other competing groups and to participate in workshops with master teachers. It is a very welcoming environment.

Key Events at JTF West

Adjudication: Groups perform 15 minutes from an MTI Broadway Junior musical for adjudication by leading theatre professionals.

Workshops: Broadway professionals and master teachers from across the country offer interactive workshops.

JTF All-Stars: Selected student performers and students technicians are chosen as festival All-stars. 2 students are chosen from each group.

New Works Showcase: Be the first to experience the exciting new Broadway Junior titles soon to be released.
