Re-Opening Survey

The Session is working to create a re-opening plan and we would like you opinion. You should have received and email from "MUP Transition Team" with a link to a Survey Monkey site. The survey should take less than 2 minutes to complete, and your responses are anonymous.

Multiple submissions are permitted to allow for multiple responses per household, but please only complete one per person.

Now that we are in the "Yellow" stage, how willing are you to return?

I would come even if I had to wear a mask

When we re-open, which scenario is most appealing:

No changes – no masks, we sing – individual and choir, you can sit where you want w/ full talk-n-terry afterward

Some changes – no masks, we sing, but have some social distancing – some pews unavailable – limited talk-n-terry – remove bibles, hymnals from pews, bulletins in pews

More changes – masks required when coming and going, but not in service, no signing, very limited talk-n-terry, nothing in pews

Most changes – masks at all times, assigned pews by family, one way in/out, very limited interaction with others, nothing in pews

How do all these items (below) impact your decision to return to the building? 1 = No impact 5 = Deal breaker

What if you had to wear a mask at all time

What if you had to wear a mask coming and going

What if there was no singing?

What if you had to maintain social distance?

What if there was no choir

What if there was no Tarry & Talk

If the building is open, how confident are you that the MUP staff can adequately clean the facilities? 1= I am comfortable the church can be adequately cleaned, 5=we need to hire outside vendor to completely sanitize and disinfect everything.

If we delay too long the resumption of normal worship, will you go somewhere else?

We are committed to continuing to offer virtual worship. Do you consider this a viable option if you are not comfortable with the re-opening options selected? (Yes, No, Somewhat)





When from duty to God I'm free,


Wonder what I'll do when my life is through,


MACKENZI COURSON will be graduating from Mars Area High School in June of 2020.
