No Cook Playdough Recipe

2 cups white flour


- 1 cup salt
- 2 tsp. cream of tartar
- 2 Tbsp. vegetable oil
- 2 cups of BOILING water with food colouring added to it

Mix all ingredients in a bowl, turn out onto counter and knead until smooth. Store in an airtight container.

Learning through Play
