9. How would you explain the following sentence: "We can avoid the extreme of trying to see Satan behind every misfortune without recognizing our personal responsibility and choice for our actions"?

10. As you struggle to run the Christian race, in what ways do you defend yourself against Satan? Do you need to renew your mind (Romans 12:2)? Are there tempting circumstances you need to avoid? What ways can you remind yourself of Jesus' victory?
