Re: URGENT: Maintaining and Securing the Legacy of the "Children's Home"

This year we are embarking upon seventy-five years of having the Children's Home positively influence and shape the lives of children and renew the bonds of families. However, this legacy is being threatened because the loan for the Children's Home and its two-hundred sixty (260) acres of land has reached its maturity date. This means that the outstanding balance of \$1.2 million is due in full by October 1, 2022.

While this may seem like an insurmountable amount, we believe that with your help, it is possible to maintain and secure the legacy of the Children's Home. There are over 1079 member churches and associations in the BGCVA. If each member church and association were to give \$1000 by September 19th, the outstanding mortgage would be paid off by the October 1, 2022, due date. With God, it is possible to do this! We owe it to the founders, former presidents, and supporters and of our two Conventions to retire the Children's Home mortgage in a manner that pleases and glorifies God! Join us in maintaining and securing the legacy of the Children's Home, as we proudly tell the story of "what these stones mean." (Joshua 4:21-24).

- This is the Baptist General Convention of Virginia contacting you to ask for your help. My name is _____and I am an ambassador for BGCVA.
- We are currently in the midst of a crucial fundraiser to save our piece of history known as The Children's Home of Virginia Baptist or CHVB. For many years CHVB has served as a residential care facility for orphans, while assisting in the developmental needs of children and their families.

It began as a residential care facility for orphans that responds to the developmental needs of children and their families.

Today, the Children's Home provides a vital service to the community on its 260 acres of land in Chesterfield. Under the motto of "Preserving the Past, Maintaining the Present, Building for the Future", the Children's Home offers Christian-based, family-centered programs for the community such as...

- The Chosen 1 Generation, a sports training and tutoring program for school-aged children.
- "His Vision Academy," a child-development program for ages 2-5.
- Christmas Blessings program which provides food to families in need during the holiday season.
- Black Cowboys & Girls is a Theatre production which gives youth experience in creative arts.
- Summer Enrichment Leadership Program.
- Before and after school program serving Chesterfield Public Schools.
