WHEREAS, the Village of Innsbrook has participated in the preparation of a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the Warren County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, hereafter referred to as the "Plan", in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and


