RULES:

1. All participants must be registered in their correct grade category.

2. ALL POEMS MUST BE MEMORIZED. Poems written by established and Avant-garde authors are acceptable. If a talented student choses to recite an original composition that he or she has written, a copy of that original composition must be submitted with this application.

3. Simple props (folding tables, dolls, chairs, etc.) can be used as part of the performance.

4. Time limits for poems are as follows:

Category I (Grade K-3) cannot exceed two minutes
Category II (4-6) cannot exceed three minutes
Category III (Grades 7-8) cannot exceed five minutes
Category IV (Grades 9-12 & Collegiate Students) cannot exceed five minutes

5. There will be 1st, 2nd and 3rd place prizes awarded within each category. All categories will be judged separately. An addition prize will be awarded for *best original composition*.

6. The competition will begin promptly at 1:00 P.M. in Fulwood Park at the Syd Blackmarr Stage. All contestants should be present by 12:30 P.M. At this time, contestants will be seated in their performance order.
