MOTOR COACH GUIDELINES – DENVER CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT

From the Parking Department, City and County of Denver

NOTE: These guidelines are subject to change at any time without notice.

LOADING/UNLOADING ZONES

Coaches must be in the act of loading or unloading to occupy a Loading Zone.

Loading Zones are available to all vehicles that are loading or unloading.

These Loading Zones can accommodate a full-sized motor coach (45 ft in length)

- Convention Center: Right side of 14th St, past California St.
- Union Station:
 - Station side of Wynkoop St, between 17th and 16th Streets.
 - Station side of Wynkoop St, after 18th St.
 - Avoid loading near the Valet Stand at the flagpole.
- Lawrence St: Right side of the street, in front of the Westin Tabor Center Hotel.
- California St: Right side of the street, between 16th and 15th Streets.
- Glenarm St: Right side of the street, between 16th and 15th Streets.
- Larimer St: Right side of the street, side just after 15th St, in front of Ocean Prime.
- Tremont St: Right side of the street, before 17th Ave, by the Holiday Inn Express.
- Grant St: Right side of the street from Colfax Ave, on the corner.
- 14th Ave: Right side of the street, between Bannock St and Broadway.

IDLING

Vehicles cannot idle for more than 5 minutes in any one-hour period unless:

- The temperature is less than 20° in the last 24-hour period.
- The latest hourly temperature is less than 10°.
- In the process of loading or discharging passengers from a transportation vehicle (a vehicle with a capacity of 16 people, minimum).

PARKING/STAGING AREAS

- Safeway: Parking lot on 22nd Ave and N Clarkson St.
- Alameda Market Place: Broadway and Alameda.
- City of Cuernavaca Park: at 19th St and Platte St.
- Little Raven St: Under the Speer Blvd Bridge; this area is designed for coach parking.
- Broadway: Between 14th Ave and Colfax Ave. Available for staging.

**Drivers are expected to know and abide by the laws and regulations of the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado.
