PERSECUTION SPURS MUSLIM FAMILY TO SUPPORT CHRISTIAN BROTHER

- Like many Bangladeshi Christians in the months since the August 2024 overthrow of the government. Arif has faced increased pressure from Muslim extremist groups because of his faith in Christ. Witnessing this. Arif's brothers, who are still Muslim, have declared their support for him & their opposition to the Muslim clerics who have harassed Arif. Pray for Arif to stand firm in the truth of 2 Cor. 4:17–18, verses he shared with front-line workers: "For this light momentary affliction is preparing us for an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison, as we look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen." Pray also that Arif's brothers. & all Muslims who are disillusioned by Islam because of extremist violence, will find peace & comfort in Jesus Christ.
- Until the 21st century. Bangladesh was considered one of the poorest countries. Though there are signs of economic growth, governmental instability continues. Churches are careful when offering relief to the poor & needy as they do not want to encourage false conversions among people claiming faith in Christ solely for economic benefit. While Bangladesh is a majority-Muslim nation, the government avoids undue influence from Islamists & actively fights extremism. Millions of Bangladeshis are learning about Christ & the Bible through media outreaches.
- 87% are Sunni Muslims & 2% are Shia Muslims. About 1/2 of 1% are Christians.
- Local Muslim authorities. Islamic extremist groups, families & communities
 persecute Christians. Hindus persecute believers in the N.W. part of the
 country, & Buddhist extremists persecute believers in the S.W.
- Christian groups meet publicly, while others worship in unregistered churches. If Muslims convert to Christianity, they're often forced to leave their community.
- The Bangladesh Bible Society/missions community have made Bibles available in many languages. But. in rural areas it is difficult finding & acquiring them.
