Camp Dates & Descriptions



June 11-14 Instruction for Beginners, 2-3:30pm

Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd Grade

This camp is designed to educate and prepare participants for the game of volleyball. Campers will be introduced to basic passing, setting, and serving. Defense and court positioning are included to provide all around team and game play instruction. It's suitable for those with little or no prior volleyball experience. Come out to work hard and have fun playing volleyball!

Serving Camp June 11-14, 3:30-4:45

This camp focuses entirely on serving. This camp is targeted at campers who have the desire to learn more of and improve on the most important skill of the game; serving. Campers can expect to touch hundreds of balls while being introduced to and learning about basic serving moves such as standing serve, jump serve, and jump-float serve techniques, as well as ball control

June 25-28 Setting and Passing Camp

3rd-5th Grade 2-3:15p, 6th-8th Grade 3:30-4:45p

9th-12th Grade 5:00-6:15p

This camp is designed to educate and prepare participants for the game of volleyball. Campers will work on proper hand and foot work for both passing and setting. Defense and court positioning are included to provide all around team and game play instruction. It's suitable for those with little or no prior volleyball experience. Come out to work hard and have fun playing volleyball!

July 23-26 Hitting, Setting, Passing Camp

3rd-5th Grade 2-3:15p, 6th-8th Grade 3:30-4:45p

9th-12th Grade 5:00-6:15p

This camp is designed to provide campers with instruction on all aspects of hitting. Campers are instructed on footwork, arm swing, and shot selection. Beginners will learn the fundamentals needed to become efficient hitters, while advanced players will work fundamentals as well as on decision-making and strategy. Campers are divided according to age/skill level. Learning groups will cover areas of attacking including: approach, take off, body awareness, arm swing, wrist/hand control, and shot selection.

In combination with aspects of Hitting, this camp is designed to give each players instruction on the setting position. Campers are instructed on hand position, footwork, tempo and accuracy of sets. Drills give campers many touches on the ball with some game-like situations included. Campers are divided according to age/skill level. Beginning setters will learn the fundamentals they must acquire for their development. More advanced setters, in addition to fundamentals, will also work on decision making and strategy.
