TMC'19 REGISTRATION FORM & QUESTIONAIRE

Thanks for committing to join the 2019 MVPA Transcontinental Motor Convoy (the TMC'19 Convoy). This Convoy is open to all registered MVPA members and all eras of Historic Military Vehicles (HMVs).

You as the HMV owner / primary driver must be a current MVPA member. MVPA membership for all other members of your crew is optional.

Please type or write-in answers to the questions below and email or mail this form to me. My contact information is at the bottom of page 6.

We are limiting the HMV roster to **100 full distance HMV teams** *plus* **20 HMV teams per "regional section"**. An "HMV team" is considered to include the HMV, the driver and a (highly recommended) co-driver (a must with all the twists and turns in this route!) and crew. Additionally, an HMV team includes an optional non-HMV support vehicle, with its driver and crew. Note - Every HMV team must include an HMV that is to be in the column. No registrations will be accepted from teams without an HMV (say, just an RV).

- These **100 full distance HMV teams** are divided (by me) into 2 groups:
 - \circ Group 1 70 HMV team registrations are open to all current MVPA members.
 - o Group 2 30 HMV team registrations will be held by me ... to be assigned to the Convoy Core team and all march unit leaders and tail gunners as they are identified (these teams still have to register and pay, of course!).
 - o ... there's no difference between Group 1 and 2 for you when registering I will sort it out on my end.
- Additionally we encourage HMV teams to join for a portion of the Convoy route ... but as another "lesson learned" from TMC'09, we will not accept having HMV teams simply drop in along the route. This is confusing for the new team joining as well as for the rest of the Convoy and unsafe for all of us including the General Public. Thus, we will only accept teams joining at rest day stops. Finally, to allow the maximum number of MVPA members to experience a portion of the Convoy, we will accept 20 HMV team registrations per "regional section". This means that you can register for any one of the following regional sections. You can select additional Regional Sections and be considered as Full Distance.
 - o Regional Section 1, 550 miles from York, PA to Wooster, OH (10 15 Aug). Rest on 16th.
 - Regional Section 2, 420 miles from Wooster, OH to the DuPage County Fairgrounds, IL (17 – 19 Aug). Rest on 20th and 21st.
 - Regional Section 3, 607 miles from the DuPage County Fairgrounds, IL to Gretna, NE (22 – 25 Aug). Rest on 26th.
 - Regional Section 4, 587 miles from Gretna, NE to Laramie, WY (27 30 Aug).
 Rest on 31st.
 - Regional Section 5, 519 miles from Laramie, WY to Tooele, UT (1 4 Sept).
 Rest on 5th.
 - Regional Section 6, 562 miles from Tooele, UT to Fallon, NV (6 9 Sept).
 Rest on 10th and 11th.
 - o Regional Section 7, 349 miles from Fallon, NV to San Francisco, CA (12 14 Sept).

• If your team wishes to join for more than 1 regional section, then you must register and pay for the full distance.

Remember! Register as soon as you can but (please) no later than 1 May, 2019.

The registration cost for this next great MVPA Convoy is priced two ways.

- a) **FULL DISTANCE** registration cost is \$300 per HMV, including an optional support vehicle and all of your crew. It is 100% <u>NON-REFUNDABLE</u> and is <u>NOT TRANSFERABLE</u>. The primary use of these funds will be to cover all costs associated with organizing this Convoy project (no MVPA money is being used). If, for some reason, you can't make the Convoy your registration package will be sent to you after the Convoy.
- b) **REGIONAL SECTION** registration cost is \$150 per HMV for ONE Regional Section. Again, this includes an optional support vehicle and all of your crew. Again, it is 100% NON-REFUNDABLE and is NOT TRANSFERABLE. If, for some reason, you can't make the Convoy your registration package will be sent to you after the Convoy.

Please make your cheque out to **MVPA Historical Archives**. <u>Please mail your cheque to me at</u> the address shown on the last page. Once I receive your payment, I will mark you as registered.

Please note: the cost per HMV for those folks who do not register before 1 May, 2019 will still be the same – but there will be no guarantee of receiving a complete registration kit.

A note regarding insurances.

We've had some members asking the questions: "What insurance do I need on my HMV?" and "What does the MVPA Chapter Insurance do for me while I am on the Convoy"? Well, I'll answer these questions here.

For your HMV and your support vehicle (if applicable), please check with your Insurance Agent to make sure that you have enough insurance to cover your assets. Remember to tell your Insurance Agent that you are traveling across the US! This needs to be your discussion with your insurance company. The needs vary by your home location ... State by State, Province by Province and Country by Country – so I will not recommend an amount of liability insurance. I further recommend that you talk with your Insurance Agent about a "personal umbrella" insurance policy that covers your assets. If you already have such an "umbrella policy", you may want to increase its value for the period of time you plan to join the Convoy. Again – TALK TO YOUR INSURANCE AGENT!

As a part of your final registration at the time you and your vehicle(s) join the Convoy we will require you to show us PROOF of insurance (not the amount – that's your business) for your vehicle(s) – the same as you would if a Police Officer asks you for this info.

For our Convoy participants joining us from outside the US, please talk with your insurance agent in your home Country to determine what personal and liability insurance you need for yourself and your HMV. You MUST have HMV insurance to legally drive on the roads in the USA!

The MVPA and the Affiliate Insurance policy covers us once we stop our Convoy during a rest stop or lunch stop or overnight/rest stop. The entire TMC'19 Convoy is an MVPA "event" – but while we are driving, our auto insurance covers us.

Finally, please feel free to forward this to other folks in your area / local MVPA affiliate that are planning to join.
