Dear Residents of The Greens of Elgin,


I wanted to use my portion of the newsletter this month to remind you all of the duties of the housekeepers.

The housekeepers complete "light" housekeeping duties only which consist of the following:

- Making beds
- Collecting garbage
- In the kitchen they will clean hard surfaces and wipe down the small appliances and wipe the countertops
- In the bathroom they will clean the toilet, sink, shower, shower doors, mirrors, sweep and mop
- Dusting (which does not include moving items)
- Vacuuming is completed last

The housekeepers will not do the following:

- Laundry
- Washing dishes
- Scrubbing floors
- Cleaning baseboards
- Cleaning the patio/balcony
- Windows or sliding door tracks
- Carpet cleaning
- Moving furniture
- Receive money for tips
- If you fall, they will call 911 and alert the front desk



Our housekeepers are on a set time for each unit to provide services to.

Should you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to contact Maria, at the Front Desk, Diane, in the Business Office, or myself in Management Office.

During the summer, I am in the office Monday through Thursday from 8am to 5pm. On Fridays, I am in the office from 9am -1pm.
