In those days, a truck tire inner tube with nylon seating sufficed.

Today’s belly boats are a far cry from the old days. At eight pounds, our belly boats are lightweight and easy to carry and maneuver. You’ll take a walk to a hidden lake, have a seat and paddle peacefully across the water on some of Ohio’s best-kept secrets – and we’re the only guide service in Ohio that can take you there.

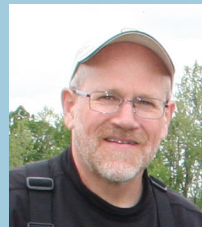

Hundreds of lakes stocked up to 60 years ago freckle the AEP ReC Lands and Woodbury and Tri-Valley Wildlife areas in Coshocton, Muskingum, Guernsey, Morgan, Noble and Perry counties. Yet, it feels like you're in Canada!

Because they're reclaimed strip mine lakes the shorelines can be thick, steep and overgrown. This makes belly boating an ideal way to access these unpressured waters. But, hire a guide or you'll get sooo lost!

WHAT'S INVOLVED IN A BELLY BOAT FISHING TREK?

- Call 740.777.2579 to make a reservation
- We'll select a set of lakes ideal for your group
- On the day of your trek, we'll meet at an easy to find crossroads and proceed from there.
- We'll take a little walk to the first lake we're fishing and provide an orientation to belly boating.
- You'll wear chest waders and sit 6" above the water on an integrated boat cushion seat as your fins propel you along.
- Our guides will provide as much or as little assistance as you'd like.
- Ohio fishing regulations apply
- **Ages 16 and older must bring an Ohio fishing license.**

ABOUT OUR BELLY BOATS

- Each includes four flotation devices: 2 pontoons, a boat cushion seat and an adjustable cushion seat back
- Life preservers are provided. Adults have the option of wearing a pfd, kids are required to wear a pfd.
- Backpack straps, zippered gear pockets, lap nets and carry-all pockets hold everything you'll need for the day
- All gear is provided including belly boat, fins, chest waders, rods and tackle
