Cost of bowling is \$8.00 per week, which includes 3 games of bowling, shoes, coaching, parties and prizes all season long. A sanction fee of \$15.00 is due the first week of bowling. This sanction fee enables all bowlers to qualify for various prizes and the support of the UNITED STATES BOWLING CONGRESS (USBC).

As a member of a Dome Lanes league, bowlers are also then qualified to bowl at open bowling times at a reduced rate of \$2.25 per game.

There is **NO SMOKING/ALCOHOL** allowed on the lanes during youth programs.

There will be **NO RUNNING OR HORSEPLAY** allowed. Children must be up to bowl on their turn or they will receive misses.

Some other activities that we will be doing as we go through the season is the USBC Pepsi Challenge qualifying which will take place Nov. 9 and Jan. 18. Anyone who does not wish to take part in this event can let Cindy know right away and they will just use their scores that day towards their averages. Anyone who makes the qualification round will advance to Regional. Cost for the Pepsi competition will be announced at a later date.

Top places from that competition will then advance to State level.

There is no fee for the state competition, it is included in the qualifying fee.

Other activities include a Halloween party, Christmas child/adult tournament, Beat the Coach and a 9-Pin tournament. With this variation, we hope to make it a more enjoyable time for the youth, while still teaching them the sport of bowling and giving them all a chance to win various awards include scholarships through the Pepsi Challenge event.
