ARC Director of Operations Report November 2021

- 1. McLean County Department of Health vaccine booster clinic had a full reserved registration schedule for Pfizer and Moderna vaccines two days before the clinic but were able to accommodate a number of walk-ins. After the CDC approved boosters for Moderna and J&J, MCHD was able to issue a standing order that was signed off and allowed boosters for these vaccines at the clinic. The next clinic is scheduled for January 28, 2022.
- 2. Veterans Day programming is off to a good start with Books on the Go on November 3 and a poetry reading November 3. Honor Flight will be presenting November 4 followed by the remainder of programs spread through the month. It is good to have ARC members involved in facilitating programs. The advisory committee is welcome to attend all programs especially the November 11 Veterans Wall dedication at 1:30pm and the November 13 Veterans Day Invocation at the flagpole at 10am featuring the Honor Guard from the VFW. This is the VFWs first time participating in our Veterans programming.
- 3. I presented on the Sunshine Program at the ECIAAA monthly advisory council retreat on November 3. The ECIAAA has provided funding for this program for more than three years totaling more than \$75,000 for Telephone Reassurance, Get Well and Sympathy Cards, equipment, and Zoom programming. Examples of the 2021 outcomes shared with the group included: 2495 Telephone Reassurance calls made; 4018 Birthday calls made; 80 Sympathy cards sent; 5 Friendly visits; 850+ Digital programs presented; 11 IL Care Connections tablets distributed; 4 Web cams distributed; 13 Echo Show devices distributed; 4 Chromebooks to be distributed.
- 4. Four members have agreed to participate in the Chromebook Program that will train them on how to use the device as another way of reducing social isolation and provide access to technology and tech competence. George Wilson, ARC's shuttle van driver will be helping facilitate training.
