### Rules

- I. This contest is open to students from 4th through 12th grades. Entries will be separated into Junior (4th-8th grades) and Senior (9th-12th grades) age divisions.
- II. Entries must have been created by the participant and must have a “**Perseverance**” theme or promote an aspect of how we can cope with trying times.
- III. Each student may enter only one poster for judging.
- IV. Entries must be no larger than half of one sheet of poster board (Maximum dimensions of 14” X 22”).
- V. There is no charge for this event, however, an entry form is required for each entry.
- VI. All entry **forms** must be received by the **Habersham County Extension** Office by September 1, 2021. Forms may be faxed to 706-754-5611. You may mail them to **555 Monroe St., Unit 50, Clarkesville, GA 30523**. Mailed entries must be postmarked by August 27, 2021. Or you may drop them off at that address between 8:00-12:00 and 1:00-5:00 Monday-Friday.
- VII. If any entry is deemed inappropriate by the fair committee or its representatives, that entry will be removed from the judging and from the display area.
- VIII. Students will receive free admission on Saturday, September 11, 2021. Names will be at the admission gate **ONLY** on the day of the contest.
- IX. The Fair Committee reserves the right to cancel this competition if there is a lack of participation
- X. Posters may be delivered to the fairgrounds between 4:00 and 6:30 PM on Thursday, September 9, 2021 or to the Habersham County Extension office before then.
- XI. The Fair Committee will not be responsible for lost or stolen entries.
- XII. All entries must be labeled on the back with the participants name, school and grade. Entries labeled on the front or not at all **will not** be eligible for judging.
- XIII. Entry into fair contests provides the entrant free admission to the fair. Multiple entries does not equal multiple admissions. Parents and other family or friends will not be admitted free of charge.
- XIV. Entries will be displayed until the end of the Chattahoochee Mountain Fair and may be picked up **at the Habersham County Extension office the week after the fair closes.**
- XV. All entries not picked up by September 30, 2021 will become property of the Chattahoochee Mountain Fair and may be subject to destruction, use in promotional materials, or any other use deemed fit by the fair committee.
