

HOMER L. KING

1913 - 1996

Homer L. King, 83, lifelong Tuscola County resident, died Friday morning, Oct. 4, at his Columbia Township home following a brief illness.

He was born in Almer Township Sept. 10, 1913, the son of Fred and Cora (Putnam) King. He was a lifelong area farmer and a longtime member of Unionville United Methodist Church.

Besides farming he had been employed with Prestolite in Bay City for about 30 years, retiring in 1973.

He was married to Leona A. Hoppe on Dec. 18, 1937, in Caro, and she survives him.

Also surviving are two children and their spouses, Earl and Rhonda King of Kingston and Mary Ann and Donald Currey of Unionville, five grandchildren and six great-grandchildren, one sister, Mildred Decker of Flint and several nieces and nephews.

He was predeceased by two sisters.

The funeral service took place at 2 p.m. Sunday, Oct. 6, in Unionville Methodist Church, with Rev. Ron Piette officiating. Burial was in Almer Township Cemetery, Caro. Ransford Funeral Home of Caro was in charge of funeral arrangements.
