

ORDINANCE NO 2009- 7

TOWN OF CLOVERDALE SEWER USE ORDINANCE

An Ordinance regulating the connection to and use of public and private sewers and drains, the installation and connection of building sewers, and the discharge of waters and wastes into the public sewer system of the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana, and providing penalties for violations thereof.

WHEREAS the Town Council of the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana operates and maintains a sewage works and is responsible for operating, maintaining, regulating, and controlling that sewage works in accordance with the requirements of law:

WHEREAS the Town Council of the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana desires to revise and update its Ordinance regulating the connection to and use of public and private sewers and drains, the installation and connection of building sewers, and the discharge of waters and wastes into the public sewer system of the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana, and providing penalties for violations thereof;

WHEREAS the Town Council of the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana desires to modify and update its prior Sewer Use Ordinances and to replace and supersede the same by this Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CLOVERDALE, INDIANA:

Section 1. This Ordinance may be referred to as the “Town of Cloverdale Sewer Use Ordinance.”

Section 2. Except as provided herein, the definitions contained in 40 CFR Section 401.11 and 40 CFR Section 403.0, as amended, shall be applicable in this Ordinance and are hereby incorporated by reference. For purposes of this Ordinance, the terms below shall be defined as follows:

(a) **“Board”** shall mean the Town of Cloverdale Utility Board or any duly authorized officials at representatives acting in its behalf.

(b) **“Building Drain”** shall mean the lowest horizontal piping of a building drainage system which receives the discharge of sewage from drainage pipes inside the walls of the building and conveys it to a point approximately five (5) feet outside the foundation wall of the building.

(c) **“Building Sewer”** shall mean the extension from the building drain to the public sanitary sewer, private sewage disposal system, or others place of disposal.
