Lodging

Location:

The venue is located in the part of Stockholm known as Söder (South), which is approx. 5 minutes by the subway (T-bana) or commuter train from Stockholm Central Station (T-Centralen, Stockholm City). The most convenient subway station is Mariatorget. If you arrive by commuter train (from the airport, for instance), Stockholms södra is the closest station. It would take you approx. 5 minutes to walk to the venue from these stations.

Getting to the venue or the hotel from the airport

There are four ways of getting from and to Arlanda Airport, north of Stockholm:

- Taxi costs approximately 500 SEK (50 euros). The market is unregulated, so make sure to pick a cab with fixed price.
- Arlanda Express is the fastest way to get to Stockholm (18 minutes), although you need to transfer at the Central Station (end station) if your hotel is located on Söder. Arlanda Express costs 299 SEK (30 euros), and you would need a SL ticket (subway or commuter train) for the trip from the Central Station to Söder (approx. 35 SEK, 3:50 euros).
- Commuter train, line 40, takes about 45 minutes and you don't have to transfer at the Central Station. The ticket costs 159 SEK (16 euros).
- Flygbussar (airport coaches) are the cheapest (100–120 SEK, 10–12 euros) and take about an hour. You would have to transfer at the City Terminal, which is next to the Central Station. Unlike the trains, the buses stop at each terminal. International flights usually land at terminal 5.
